



## Summer “Business House” League 2007/2008 Information & Rules

### Information

Day of play:	Thursday
Period of play:	Thursday 1 <sup>st</sup> November to Thursday 13 <sup>th</sup> December 2007 & Thursday 10 <sup>th</sup> January to Thursday 7 <sup>th</sup> February 2008
Times:	Two sessions of play either 6.30pm start or 8pm start. This may change depending on the entries
Cost:	Entry fee is \$200 <u>per team</u> .
Shuttles:	Teams will provide their own shuttles. Shuttles can be purchased through the PRO Shop
Shield Grade:	For teams with a majority of A and/or B grade players
Social Grade:	For teams with a majority of C and/or D grade and/or ungraded players
Payment:	Entry form must include payment of \$200
Closing date:	26 <sup>th</sup> October 2007 at 5pm

### Rules

1. Non-marking sports shoes must be worn on court.
2. Teams shall consist of four players, which must include at least one female.
3. Team members must play in order of merit.
4. All matches are doubles, with each team member playing with each other team member against their opposite number (3 matches each team member, 6 matches per tie).
5. Matches are one game to 31 points as per the new rally scoring system. If the score becomes 30-all the side which gains a two point advantage will win the game. If the score becomes 34-all the side winning the 35<sup>th</sup> point shall win the game.
6. The winner of a tie is the team that wins most matches; if the matches are equal then the points are counted, if points are equal then the tie is drawn.
7. Championship Points are allocated 1 for each match won and 2 for winning the tie
8. The Shield Grade winner will be the team that wins all its ties. If no team wins all its ties then the team scoring the most Championship Points will be the winner.
9. The Business House Shield will be awarded to the winner of the Shield Grade at the end of the competition.  
The Business House Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the Social Grade at the end of the competition.
10. The Tournament Controller reserves the right to re-grade any team or player.
11. If a player is injured during a game, the match will be defaulted. The injured player can be replaced by a team member but the match will not be counted.
12. If a team wishes to replace any current team members due to injuries, work commitment, illness etc, the tournament controller must be advised as soon as possible prior to the game.
13. Players on a team list are not allowed to play for more than one team throughout the tournament. However, a player (who is not listed in any team) is allowed to act as a reserve for more than one team.
14. The Tournament Controller reserves the right to alter the format of the tournament, depending on the entries received.
