Porcelain Cup

What is the Porcelain Cup ?

The Porcelain Cup is an annual friendly competition between the VUBC and the Wellington Badminton Club (WBC). It starts off with the Badminton tournament and finishes off with a joint luncheon and awards giving

Who can play ?

Anyone, of any Grade can participate. The tournament is open to Casuals as well. If you want to participate, please register with Chris (chris.r.buehler@gmail.com) by 19th August

Where is held ?

WBA Badminton Hall, 1 Ruahini Str. ,Hataitai, Wellington

When is it ?

22nd August, 10.30am (runtime: approximately 3 hours)

How much does it cost ?

\$5 for anyone

How does it work ?

On arrival, Clubs officials rank their players from Top to bottom player. Participants are put into boxes, top 4 players in Box 1, player 5-8 in box 2, player 9-12 in box 3 etc. The 4 VUBC players in each box play doubles with their box teammates against the WBC players (VUBC Player 1 + VUBC Player 2 vs WBC Player 1 vs WBC Player 2, then VUBC Player 3 + VUBC Player 4 vs WBC Player 3 + WBC Player 4). Altogether every participant will play around 3-4 doubles. Counting system is one game to 21points, no setting. At the end, whoever wins more ties will win the Porcelain Cup. In 2008 the Porcelain Cup went to the WBC
